

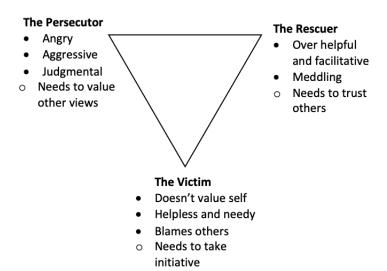
Effective Team and Relationship Building

- Addresses one's own needs
- Clarifies personal values and honor others'
- Asks for what one wants & needs
- Sets boundaries and trusts others

Teams need a blend of all four decision-making styles

Effective professionals learn to communicate and function in all four arenas

- Influential: inspirational, interactive, interesting (need to learn to listen / comply)
- Steady: stable, supportive, sincere. (need to learn to disagree / disrupt / exert opinion)
- **Compliant**: cautious, careful, conscientious. (need to learn to take risks / say yes / flex)
- **Dominant**: drives, directs, decisive (need to earn to stop, relax, let it go)

Strategies for Growth and Team Building

- o Pause: Staying calm and collected helps to avoid unhealthy conflict
- Avoid Enemy Energy: Use disagreement as opportunity to learn from each other, appreciate differences, rather than assign bad intentions to others
- Stay and play; de-escalate, self-regulate, endure, reframe
- DONT complain / lecture / attack / scold. DO praise, ask, assist, be brief, be friendly
